Please look through the course offerings. We are sure there is something of interest for everyone. Come and explore with us during the summer of 2004!

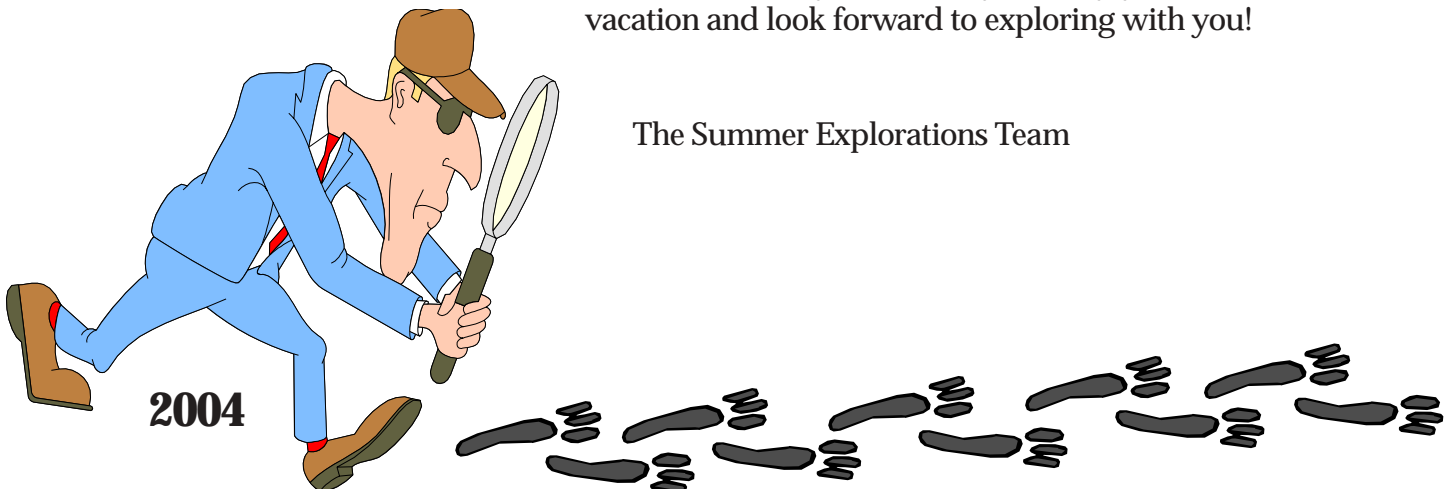

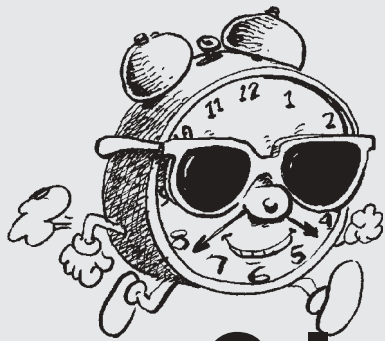

Classes

The fun is just beginning...

Jump Start South **Pre-Kindergarten** **9:00-12:00**

Get a jumpstart on your child's readiness skills and enroll them in our Pre K summer program. From the first day your child will be immersed in language through phonemic awareness activities, word play, print skills, rhymes, songs and poetry. Children will participate in cooperative group activities and explore math skills through hands-on games and interactive play. Our three-hour program will also include a snack and daily recess break.

The goal of this program is to introduce children to what will be expected of them as Kindergarten students. It will also establish a positive learning experience to use as a building block as they begin their Kindergarten year.

Drop Everything and Read **Grades 1-2**

This fun and exciting course is perfect for anyone who is imaginative and adventurous. You will enhance and develop a love for reading through this class. Students will strengthen vocabulary and comprehension skills through wonderful literature, games, role-playing and discussions. Weekly visits to the library are included.

Computer Capers **Grades 1-3**

It is never too early to begin extending your child's comfort level with computers. This class allows for exploration. Children will experience great reading, writing and math software. Much of this software is used on a regular basis in school. Each child will have a chance to produce and bring home original computer artwork.

Math Blasters **Grades 1-3**

Math can be, and should be, FUN. This will be a fun-filled class with many hands-on activities that will reinforce the math concepts all children have been exposed to in school. Practice and reinforce math through games, computer programs, read aloud stories and active participation.

Outdoor Games **Grades 1-3**

This is a games class for enthusiastic and energetic boys and girls. It provides an opportunity for participation in a variety of sports activities. The emphasis is on good sportsmanship and fun. We will spend as much time as possible outside and use the gym as necessary.

Scrumptious Creations **Grades 1-3**

Smell the aroma of delicious treats cooking. Join us as we stir ingredients together into scrumptious cooked and "no-bake" creations. Math concepts such as volume, weights and fractions will be highlighted through the use of great read aloud literature. The students will create a special cookbook as a culminating project.

Theater Games **Grades 1-3**

Young children sometimes make the best actors. Children in this class will practice and produce a play. They will create characters, dialogue, costumes and scenery. The class will culminate in a final production to be presented to parents, so have your video cameras ready.

Come Travel with Us to French Speaking Countries **Grade 3-5**

We will sing, dance, create art projects, eat and read our way through different countries where French is spoken. We will also learn vocabulary which goes along with the classroom adventures we will be taking to the various countries. *Allez, viens!*

Learn the Piano **Grades 3-5**

Are you interested in playing the piano but don't have access to one at home? This class, for **BEGINNERS ONLY**, will include group and individual instruction as well as time to practice. Our new pianists will perform during the final class. **Activity fee \$20.00 (Limited class size)**

Bookmaking for Beginners **Grades 3-6**

In this class we will learn to make our own books with everyday supplies. Students will have the option to create various books, including pop-ups, accordions, story books and picture books. We will work on creating perfect works of art that incorporate language arts skills as well. This is an ideal class to foster a love for reading at any age!

Math Review **Grade 4**

Students will review the key concepts from the school year. Concepts will include comparing numbers, addition and subtraction of multi-digit numbers, word problems, measurement, money, fractions, and multiplication facts. This class is for students who are entering 4th grade only.

Writers Respond! **Grades 4-5**

This course is designed for children entering 4th or 5th grade who enjoy writing and want to expand on their prior knowledge. The children will review narrative, expository and persuasive writing, and have several opportunities to practice responding to various prompts. This class will use several of the tools designed by writing specialist, Gretchen Courtney, who has been the district's main writing consultant. Maintaining focus, adding depth and specificity are just a few of the areas we will explore.

3,2,1, Blast Off! **Grades 4-8**

This class is an introduction to Model Rocketry. Students build their own solid fuel rockets while learning how to read detailed plans, use materials carefully, and problem solve. Investigate the history and principles of rocketry. Students experience the thrill of launching their own creation. (Materials Fee \$30-\$40)

Architecture thru the Ages **Grades 4-8**

Need some ideas to build upon? Explore the history of architecture and understand its concepts through hands-on activities. There will be an emphasis on observing local architecture through field trips. The class will end up constructing buildings the "Wright" way.

Artists in Residence **Grades 4-8**

Get ready to have fun with all kinds of materials. Students will use charcoals, inks, paints and pastels on different surfaces to create works of art. The lucky experimenters in this class will find out what can be created while exploring different media. The emphasis will be on drawing and painting.

Beginning Guitar **Grades 4-8**

Start the day with a song, a chord & some strumming. Learn more about guitar skills and some new songs to play. An instrument is needed; rental options will be discussed at the first class.

Flash Story-telling Grades 6-8

Learn the Piano Grades 3-5
Are you interested in playing the piano but don't have access to one at home? This class, for BEGINNERS ONLY, will include group and individual instruction as well as time to practice. Our new pianists will perform during the final class. Activity fee \$20.00 (Limited class size)

The Curtain is Up! Grade 3-5
This course is designed for students entering 3rd, 4th and 5th grade, and want to explore the theater. Throughout the four week course, the children will take part in several exercises that prepare them for the stage. We will engage in several exercises that work on breathing, voice and dramatics. Each participant will also get to take part in producing a play to be performed at the end of the summer session. They will construct a set, design costumes, and perform in a play.

Come Travel with Us to Spanish Speaking Countries Grade 3-5

Cartoon Art Grades 4-8
Want to draw your own super hero? Ever wish you could create a comic book? This your chance to learn to draw comic book characters, create storyboards, and produce a finished product that would make Spiderman jealous.

Lights, Camera, Action Grades 4-8

This class is designed to support students in developing lifelong organizational and study skills. After taking this course, students will be better equipped to enter the next school year.

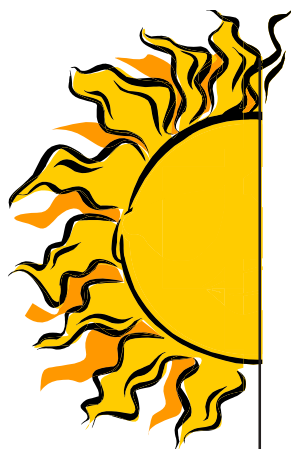
Math Games for Masterminds Grades 5-6

Jump Start Math Grade 7

Math can be fun and exciting. Come learn to play with numbers. Practice and renew your old skills and develop new ones while having a great time using computers, manipulatives and games. This class will help prepare you for the next school year.

Writer's Workshop Grade 8

Join the ranks of great writers everywhere. Polish your skills in an interesting atmosphere. Learn new tricks, become a better writer and get ready for the next school year. Produce fabulous works that you'll be proud to share.

Fairy Tale Magic Grades 1-3

Recyclable Art Grades 1-3

What better way to learn to recycle than to make cool projects? If you enjoy creating or making art out of found objects, this is the class for you. We will be experimenting with sculpture, collage and all kinds of materials you bring from home.

Number Munchers Grades 2-3

Do you love numbers? Is math your favorite subject? Come and have fun with double-digit addition and subtraction. Learn about multiplication and division using hands-on manipulatives and games. See how much fun math is using great programs on the computer.

Research Class Grades 2-3

This is a perfect class for the exploring mind. Children will be using the computer as well as other material to gather information and organize the research into a product that they will share.

Young Athletes Grades 2-4

Come and have fun in the Gymnasium while using the indoor sports equipment. Play basketball, crab soccer, pin guard and many other games.

Artists and their Stories Grades 3-5

Every picture tells a story. Learn about some of art history's most interesting artists and their stories. After reading and discussing the lives of each artist, students will have the opportunity to create a project(s) using a similar style or technique as the artist. (We will also explore the historical context, influences, and traditions in which the artist was living and working.)

Learn to Fly (Class size 10 students) Grades 3-5

Students will design and construct their own paper airplanes and kites, as well as learn about the concepts of aerodynamics. They will learn from trial and error. When weather permits, students will test their airplanes and kites outdoors and, of course, the main objective is to have fun.

Courses lacking sufficient enrollment after April 30 are subject to re-organization and/or cancellation. Students will then be placed in their alternate choice (if available). All registrations will be confirmed by mail. Parents have until May 14 to accept alternate placement or request a refund.
