1. The School District has again purchased, on your behalf, a "school-time" accident insurance program for your child(ren). This coverage applies to school-time only, and 24-hour coverage is available at your cost. No action is required if there is no need for 24-hour coverage. Coverage is provided automatically. If you desire to purchase additional coverage, please enroll on-line as explained in the posted flyer. These additional types of insurances are initiated by you directly with the carrier.

In the event of an accident during the school year, please contact the School District Business Office (847-835-7800) for the appropriate claim forms. As accidents are reported to the District Office from the School Nurse, we will correspond with you concerning the need for these claim forms.
