**Assessment within our Schools:**

The District's Assessment Plan will provide analysis of student performance to indicate the number and percentage of all students attaining and exceeding the district and state performance standards. The plan will also be used to identify significant patterns of growth or achievement discrepancies. The plan will provide for the assessment of organizational achievement in terms of all district goals. District teams will establish baselines for all data sources so that progress can be analyzed over time. Data will be analyzed by teams and considered with respect to student progress and need for interventions. District teams will share successful programming and strategies to support growth for our students.

**Collaborative Decisions by District and School Teams:**

- Establish priorities for student growth on a yearly basis
- Evaluate programs and services in terms of district priorities
- Identify how students perform relative to local, township, state, and national standards
- Develop instructional strategies that address various learning styles and modalities
- Create staff development activities that enhance the staff's ability to meet the needs of all students
- Use assessment data to refine and adjust daily practice consistent with the District's goals
