

<p>MINUTES OF HEARING for 2012-2013 SCHOOL CALENDAR Monday, December 12, 2011</p>

President Eddie Chez called the Hearing to order at 7:35 p.m. on Monday, December 12, 2011 in Young Auditorium of Central School, Glencoe, Illinois.

ROLL CALL

Dr. Crawford indicated that changes in state law have allowed for modifications to the school calendar at the local level. This change in the law allowed for a public hearing to discuss the recommendation to hold school, teacher institute days, parent/teacher conferences, or staff development activities on the following legal school holidays:

- The birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. (Third Monday in January)
- The birthday of President Abraham Lincoln (February 12)
- The birthday of Casimir Pulaski (First Monday in March)
- Columbus Day (Second Monday in October)
- Veteran's Day (November 11)

The purpose of the hearing was to receive testimony from educators and parents regarding the intent to hold school on Tuesday, February 12, 2013, Lincoln's Birthday, and intent to hold school on Monday, March 4, 2013, Casimir Pulaski Day.
