Literary Term
"Flip Book"

Directions: In the novel you read, you will be asked to find examples of various literary terms within the text. As you come across these in your reading, you should mark them with a post-it so you can later go back and insert the example into your flip book. You must choose **eight** of the following ten terms, and **find an example** of each term in your text.

You will be making a "flip book" with these eight terms. You may design this book however you choose. You may make it whatever size, shape, color, or design you wish. The style of the book may vary between students, as long as, the following pieces are included. You may even wish to incorporate technology. If technology is used, share your idea with Mrs. Gabriel **first**. You will be graded on how well the following detailed directions are followed.

On the front cover:

Include your name, 7-period #, and the date it is due. Also include the title of the novel being used and its author.

Each page:

- * The **name of the term** chosen (should be easy to see)
- * A complete and thorough **definition** of the term.
- * A **quotation from the novel**, in which that literary term is being used. You must have at least one, but may choose to have more. Be sure to use the appropriate punctuation and quotation marks! The **page number** in which this quotation can be found in the text must also be included.
- * An illustration that either portrays the example given from the text or that creates an image of the literary term. This can be hand drawn, cut from magazines, from clip art, etc.

In general:

- * All work should be done in color.
- * Information should be placed on each page in an organized manner utilizing the space.
- * The work should be clear, neat, attractive, informative and accurate.
- * You may explain your examples or illustrations if they are unclear.
