

Holiday Light Recycling Program

The Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County (SWANCC) and the Village are once again offering a holiday light recycling program, free of charge. Residents can drop off old string lighting at the Hazel Avenue entrance to the Public Works Garage from December 1 – March 15, 2012 between 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Materials accepted for recycling include: mini-lights (or Italian lights), C7 lights, C9 lights, rope lights, LED lights and extension cords. All colors and lengths will be accepted. The Village cannot accept live garland and wreaths for recycling due to the significant wiring used in their assembly. These should be placed in your regular garbage.
